Tournament Format

Two day (Sat. & Sun.) 36 hole stroke play individual competition (gross & net) AND fun 18 hole 4-person team competition concurrently on Saturday only. Sunday pairings will be by division of play.

Teams on Saturday will be mixed and assigned by the Tournament Committee, with A,B,C,D players on each team. Scoring will be 1 gross plus 2 net scores each hole, with no player's score counting twice on the same hole, e.g. gross & net. Tee times will start at 10:00 a.m. each day. Awards follow play on Sunday.
